Earthquake in Japan

Dear customers,

In consideration of the occurrences in Fukushima, we observed a growing concern amongst our customers particularly with regard to the possibility of radioactively contaminated goods.

For your guidance, we would like to inform you that we have no production facilities in Japan, and that our products are predominantly manufactured in Europe and the USA.

In so far as our products also contain components from Japan, we would like to point to the information of the Bundesamt für Strahlenschutz (BfS - the Federal Office for Radiation Protection). The obligation to control the import of goods and other objects at the frontiers, including the airports and ports, is primarily incumbent on the German Federal Police and Customs. In the event that, subsequent to the import of merchandise, there is justified suspicion of possible radioactive contamination, the Radioactivity Measurements Laboratories of the German States are put in charge of the measurement and radiological assessment.

This being the situation, there is no evidence suggesting radioactive contamination of the individual components we procure.

In our company, the earthquake in Japan has no influence on our ability to supply. We are in constant touch with our suppliers to avoid delivery delays.
